Logistics Civil Augmentation Program (LOGCAP)

As a U.S. Army contractor, KBRwyle has supported military contingency activity, on a global basis, since the first major LOGCAP task was awarded in 1992. Currently, under LOGCAP IV, KBRwyle supports a population of approximately 18,000 personnel spanning 40 locations across the Middle East and Europe, delivering life support and logistics, O&M, and general construction. At the start of Operation Inherent Resolve in 2015, 27 KBRwyle employees rapidly deployed to Iraq delivering 23 different services on one site within the first two weeks.



LOGCAP IV EUCOM

As part of the LOGCAP IV EUCOM scope, KBRwyle provides rapid response support to scheduled and unscheduled theatre-wide U.S. Army training exercises. KBRwyle supported Saber Guardian 2017 with 17 sites in Austria, Hungary, Bulgaria and Romania. This exercise involved more than 20,000 U.S. and multinational troops.

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
