Since 1995, under an interrupted series of sequential contracts, KBRwyle has provided support to U.S. Army Europe at Camp Bondsteel in Kosovo, Mihall Kogalniceanu Airbase in Romania, and ancillary permanent and temporary sites located throughout Eastern Europe.

During 2016, contracting authority for these sites was passed from U.S. Army Europe to the Logistics Civil Augmentation Program (LOGCAP) contracting command in Rock Island, Illinois. Awarded as a series of tasks under the active LOGCAP IV program, KBRwyle's period of performance for these sites has been extended through September 2018.

We currently provide a full spectrum of base operation and maintenance, base life support, logistics support, specialized design, and construction services to a population ranging from 750 to 2,200 US forces and up to 600 multi-national forces annually. Significant KBRwyle effort is dedicated to Forward Operating Base (FOB) O&M in support of joint military force exercises and rotational training missions at 21 individual FOBs in Kosovo, Romania, Turkey and Bulgaria.
