## Facility and System

## Logistics Civil Augmentation Program (LOGCAP) IV EUCOM

Through a series of four consecutive contracts since 1995, KBRwyle has provided base operations support (BOS) and indefinite delivery/indefinite quantity construction for U.S. Army Europe on 25 base camps and 30+ forward operating sites. Our work spans Bosnia, Croatia, Hungary, Macedonia, Kosovo, Romania, Turkey and Bulgaria, and included a temporary refugee camp in Albania. We maintain 3,600+ facilities across 27,000 square miles for populations that often exceed 10,000 U.S. and multinational forces.

## Camp Lemonnier, Djibouti O&M

KBRwyle provides full-service base operations support services for Camp Lemonnier, the remote Chebelley Airfield site on the Somalia Border, and a forward operating base in Kenya. We serve a large population of contractor and military personnel at both locations. In addition to maintaining over a large number of base facilities spanning three sites and two countries, we also augment and enhance quality of life support at each site. Camp Lemonnier has experienced exponential growth during the time KBRwyle has managed the facility, and it has converted from an “expeditionary base” to an “Enduring Facility”, heightening the criticality of the U.S. mission in Djibouti and the nature of the support that KBRwyle continues providing for Naval Facilities Engineering Command in the AFRICOM operating theatre.
